

Driving directions to Aurora BayCare through Green Bay construction.

Traveling north on I-43 from the Milwaukee area: Continue on I-43 north to Mason Street (Exit 183). Turn right on Mason Street. Turn right onto Ontario. Turn right onto Greenbrier Road. Follow the signs to the Emergency Department.

Traveling north on US 41 from the Fox Cities: Continue on US 41 north to I-43 (Exit 171). Take I-43 south toward Milwaukee to Mason Street (Exit 183). Turn left on Mason Street. Turn right onto Ontario. Turn right onto Greenbrier Road. Follow the signs to the Emergency Department.



Traveling south on WIS 54/57 from Door County: When WIS 54/57 junctions with I-43, take I-43 to the south toward Milwaukee. Take the Mason Street exit (Exit 183). Turn left onto Mason Street. Turn right on Ontario. Turn right onto Greenbrier Road. Follow the signs to the Emergency Department.

Traveling south on US 41 from Oconto and Marinette Counties: When US 41 junctions with I-43, take I-43 south (Exit 171) toward Milwaukee. Take the Mason Street exit (Exit 183). Turn left on Mason Street. Turn right on Ontario. Turn right onto Greenbrier Road. Follow the signs to the Emergency Department.

Traveling east on US 29 from Shawano: Take US 41 north to I-43 (Exit 171). Take I-43 south toward Milwaukee to Mason Street (Exit 183). Turn left on Mason Street. Turn right onto Ontario. Turn right onto Greenbrier Road. Follow the signs to the Emergency Department.
